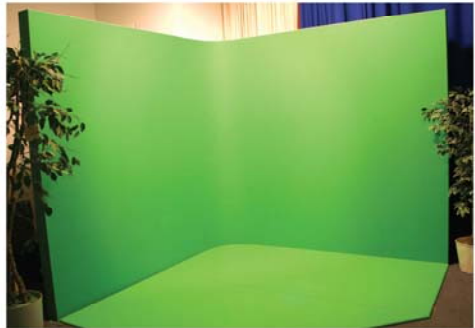
## Training Class
