L1. WRITTEN MOTION, Councillor Lopes, requesting that DPI Commissioner Labelle have the sand barrels placed out across the City, and at each of the previous locations.

L2. WRITTEN MOTION, Councillor Coelho, on behalf of numerous concerned citizen calls, requesting IMMEDIATELY that the sand barrels be placed at various parts throughout the City as in previous years, and now that the barrels are placed in the City parks it's creating a public safety issue for the elderly who cannot make it to parks for said sand collection to properly treat their property; and further, requesting that the Mayor request that the Department of Public Infrastructure place the sand barrels at various parts of the City for this winter season and notify all residents early next year regarding sand barrel placement so our residents can plan accordingly.

L3. COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, to City Council regarding the two pending appointments to the Library Board of Trustees.

L4. COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, to City Council, submitting the APPOINTMENT of FATHER KEVIN HARRINGTON, New Bedford, MA, to the LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES, replacing Mary Ellen Bergeron, whose term has expired; this term will expire April 2016.

L5. WRITTEN MOTION, Councillors Saunders, Martins and Council President Duarte, requesting that the City Solicitor draft the necessary documents to convey or sell an interest in the real property located at 26 Madeira Avenue to the Alma del Mar Charter School, or a non-profit real estate holding entity wholly owned by Alma del Mar Charter School (in either event, a Commonwealth Charter School intending to utilize said real property for the public purpose of providing public education) in accordance with applicable State law, provided that such documents of conveyance include provisions: (i) sufficient to accommodate the reasonable annual temporary and partial use of said real property by the Feast of the Blessed Sacrament; and (ii) containing adequate protection of the City's property rights should the building no longer be used for educational purposes, the method for establishing the final price of said conveyance shall be established by the City Council and approved by the Mayor.
