COMMUNICATION/DEMOLITION, New Bedford Historical Commission, to City Council, re: BUILDING DEMOLITION REVIEW OF 1771 ACUSHNET AVENUE, CIRCA 1916 ONE-STORY BRICK AND CONCRETE BLOCK STRUCTURE – advising that “the structure is not located in a National Register Historic District, the structure is of no notable historic significance, either recorded or found with the existing condition of the structure, therefore, “the NBHC has determined that 1771 Acushnet Avenue is NOT a historically significant building or structure and not preferably preserved”.
