RESOLUTION HONORING RELAY FOR LIFE ON THE OCCASION OF THEIR THIRTIETH ANNIVERSARY

WHEREAS, Once a year, the American Cancer Society holds an organized community fundraising walk entitled “Relay For Life”, an event that brings people of all ages and backgrounds to celebrate the lives of those who have battled cancer, as well as share recent advancements in research and raise significant funds for this important cause; and

WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society’s Relay For Life is the world’s largest and most impactful fundraising event to end cancer, it unites communities across the globe to celebrate people who have battled cancer, honor loved ones lost, inspires action to finish the fight once and for all, is supported by thousands of volunteers, and is helping the American Cancer Society is helping to save more than four hundred lives a day; and
