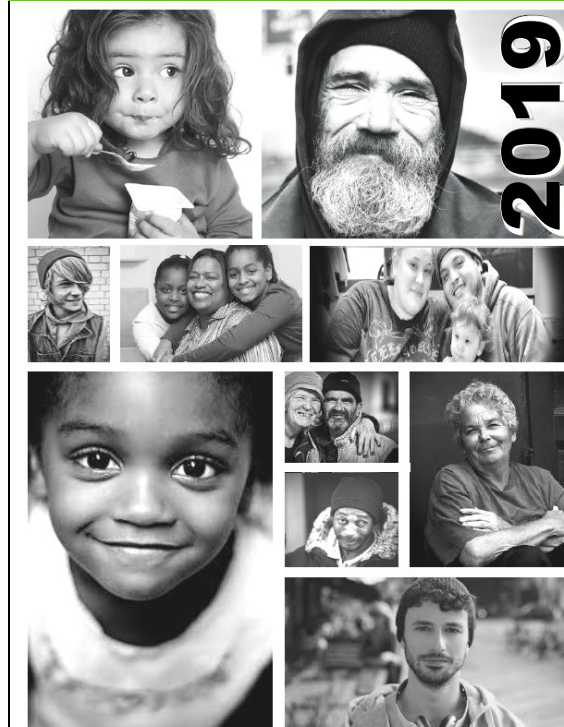

get in their shelter programs. As of December 1st,
2015, everyone and every agency in New Bedford [and
all of Bristol County] is using ONE phone number to
connect folks to the shelter they need.

You must call this number from a local area code;
that means it will only work if you call from a phone
with a 508 or 774 area code.
From outside these area codes call 1.508.674.4681.
