PROJECT SUMMARY:

The property is a c. 1878 transitional Greek Revival and Italianate building abutting the western edge of the National Register historic district. As part of Mayor Lang's "Building a Better New Bedford" Initiative, the building came to the City's possession from tax title. In 2007, The City issued a request for proposals for the sale of the property. The property was awarded to Pamela and Crisanto DosSantos, a New Bedford couple who are in the process of rehabilitating the home to use as their primary residence, converting the home from a three-family to a single family. Mr. DosSantos is a returned Iraq War veteran.




UNIT SIZE AND CONFIGURATION:
