
PROJECT SUMMARY:

The former Kinyon Campbell School has been redeveloped by the award-winning Women's Institute; a Boston based non-profit housing developer, in collaboration with North Star Learning Center. The renovation of the school building included twelve two-and-three-bedroom affordable apartments. North Star Learning Center operates a community center on the bottom level, offering area residents and building dwellers a range of services, such as after-school programs, job training, adult education classes, a teen center, and a resource and referral center. The project has been completed since 2006, and serves 50 children a year.
