Dear Community Partner:

In November of 2012 several community organizations participated in a community dialogue facilitated by the Department of Justice to address issues of tension and conflict within our community. As a community, we identified issues and solutions which we collectively accepted as a plan of action.

Some of the issues of agreement included that the immigrant communities in New Bedford may not understand their civil rights and another was that the role of the New Bedford Public Schools in preventing negative interactions between youth and police could be better defined and expanded.

To date, in addressing some of the issues, many of the stakeholders have continued to pool their resources together to assist the Central American community on issues of safety, inclusion, and knowledge of civil rights. Mayor, Jonathan F. Mitchell has appointed the first Guatemalan woman to the Human relations Commission. The HRC held presentations and role play with students at Trinity Day Academy and Whaling City Alternative High Schools on "What to do when stopped by a police officer." It was quite successful with all participants benefitting from the engagement.

The action plan is a five year plan and there is much more to accomplish. On May 16th, 3-5 in room 314 at New Bedford city hall, we invite you to attend a meeting to address 7 issues of concern expressed by community organizers of the Central American community. We will include the issues on the agenda which will be forwarded to you prior to the meeting date. The hope is, collectively we will be able to explore options leading to solutions to some of these concerns through creating more collaborative partners. The meeting will be facilitated by members of the Department of Justice. The issues of concern are on public safety, and inclusion.

We ask that you send representation from your organization to assist in finding solutions to these issues of concern. **Please reply to this email if you will be able to attend or need additional information.** Your participation will be greatly appreciated.
