

Notification to Abutters Under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act

In accordance with the second paragraph of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40, you are hereby notified of the following:

- A. The name of the applicant is: BlueWave Capital
- B. The applicant has filed a Request for Amended Order of Conditions (OOC) with the Conservation Commission for the municipality of Dartmouth seeking approval of activity within an Area Subject to Protection Under the Wetlands Protection Act (General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40).
- C. The address of the lot where the activity is proposed is located off Castaldi Drive, as shown on Assessor's Map 84, Lots 7, 8 and 8-18 and on Assessor's Map 85, Lots 7 and 8. An Amended Order of Conditions is required to address various plan changes that have resulted from DEP Review of the proposed solar project. These changes include a reduction in the overall footprint of the project and the elimination of two proposed permanent wetland crossings.
