## TIRE RECYCLING DAY

**Saturday, Sept. 20, 2014 - 9 am to noon**

**Who:** New Bedford or Dartmouth residents only (ID required)

**Where:** Shawmut Avenue Transfer Station, 1103 Shawmut Avenue, New Bedford

**Cost:** **Cash or check only**  
\$1 each for car tires  
\$5 each for light duty truck tires  
\$15 each for heavy duty truck tires



No commercial loads, no off-road equipment tires. No tires greater than R24.

## PAPER SHREDDING DAY

**Saturday, Sept. 20, 2014 - 9 am to noon**

**Who:** Greater New Bedford residents & businesses

**Where:** Parking lot across from City Hall. Corner of William & North 6th Streets (enter on William Street)

**Cost:** \$5 per box (not more than 40 pounds each)

\$5 to destroy a hard drive

**What:** Paper clips & staples do not need to be removed, but please remove paper from binders or folders.

## NATIONAL DRUG TAKE-BACK DAY and SHARPS Drop-Off Day

**Saturday, Sept. 27, 2014 - 10 am to 2 pm**

**Who:** Drug Take-Back - Open to all  
Sharps Drop-Off - New Bedford or Dartmouth residents only (ID required)

**Where:** New Bedford Police Department Headquarters, 871 Rockdale Avenue

**What:** Safely dispose of unwanted prescription drugs and sharps (needles, syringes & lancets). Sharps must be in a red biohazard container prior to the drop-off day.

Call (508) 979-1493 to ask where to obtain one free biohazard container. Additional containers may be purchased from the pharmacy.



## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE Drop-Off Day

**Saturday, Oct. 18, 2014 - 9 am to noon**

**Who:** New Bedford or Dartmouth residents only (ID required). Collection is for households only, not businesses, schools or contractors.

**Where:** Crapo Hill Landfill, 300 Samuel Barnet Blvd., New Bedford (Call for directions or visit [www.gnbrrmdistrict.org](http://www.gnbrrmdistrict.org))

**What:** Most types of household hazardous wastes will be accepted including oil-based paints, paint thinner & waste fuels. NO LATEX PAINTS (dry out and throw away in the regular trash).



The maximum amount you can bring is 25 gallons or 25 pounds.
