**9 am to noon**




- Who:** New Bedford & Dartmouth residents only (ID required)

- What:** Sharps may not be placed in the trash. Sharps must be in a red biohazard container prior to the event.
- Call (508) 979-1493 to ask where to obtain one free biohazard container. Additional containers may be purchased from the pharmacy.

- Who:** New Bedford & Dartmouth residents only (ID required)
- Where:** Shawmut Avenue Transfer Station, 1103 Shawmut Avenue, New Bedford
- Cost:** **Cash or check only**  
\$1 each for car tires  
\$5 each for light duty truck tires  
\$15 each for heavy duty truck tires  
(no more than 6 heavy duty tires)

No commercial loads, no off-road equipment tires. No tires with a rim diameter greater than 24 inches. Rims are okay.

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE Drop-Off Day

**9 am to noon**



- Who:** New Bedford & Dartmouth residents only (ID required). Collection is for households only.
- Where:** Crapo Hill Landfill, 300 Samuel Barnett Blvd., New Bedford (Call for directions or visit [www.gnbrrmdistrict.org](http://www.gnbrrmdistrict.org))
- What:** All types of household hazardous wastes are accepted including oil-based paints, paint thinner & waste fuels. NO LATEX PAINTS (dry out and throw it away in the regular trash).

The maximum amount you can bring is 25 gallons or 25 pounds.
