Food for Fines Returns

The Library is pleased to be bringing back its Food for Fines program this holiday season.

Now is the time to clear up your overdue fines and start the year with a clean slate! Or if you've been scared to bring back that long-overdue book, movie or other item, there's no need to fear anymore!

From now until November 30, the library will dismiss your fines when you bring in non-perishable or canned goods.

One can or other food item will be accepted for each \$1.00 owed in fines.

Used and expired food will not be accepted, and food cannot be used to pay for items that have been permanently lost. Some examples of non-perishable foods include: macaroni, cereal, rice, spaghetti and sauce, macaroni and cheese and canned foods such as meats, soups, fruits and vegetables.

Food, overdue items and library materials will be accepted at all New Bedford libraries. Library patrons are encouraged to return overdue materials and help fight hunger at the same time.

The food collected at the libraries will be given to the PACE Emergency Food Bank, which assists more than 4,000 households each year. Contributions from the general public, who do not have fines, are greatly encouraged.
