New Bedford Parks Recreation & Beaches Invites Local Non-Profits to Apply for Waiver of Greens Fees at the Whaling City Golf Course

New Bedford, Massachusetts—New Bedford Parks Recreation & Beaches has released the 2014 Application to Waive the Green Fees for the Whaling City Golf Course. Non-profit organizations wishing to hold a golf tournament at the Whaling City Golf Course may apply for a waiver of the Greens Fees by completing and submitting an application by March 21, 2014. Applications will be reviewed at the March meeting of the Park Board of Commissioners.

Non-profit organizations are encouraged to apply with the stipulation that tournaments held on weekdays (if selected) will not require any food obligations to the Whaling City Golf Course. Weekend tournaments (if selected) will require a food concession agreement.

In addition to completing the application, applicants must also describe the organization's mission, its importance to the community, as well as how it intends to use the proceeds from the golf tournament.
