### Sections of East and West Beach Closed to Swimming Today

**New Bedford, Massachusetts-** The New Bedford Health Department has announced that several sections of East Beach located along East Rodney French Boulevard and West Beach located along West Rodney French Boulevard have been closed to swimming today, Thursday, July 17, 2014 due to elevated bacteria levels. The Health Department has closed the following beach sections to swimming to protect public health:

- East Rodney French Boulevard Sections: Tower 1, Tower 4, Davy's Locker
- On West Rodney French Boulevard Sections: Kid's Beach, J Beach, Squid Beach

However, water testing results also indicate that the water quality is acceptable for swimming at North 400 and South 400 beach on West Rodney French Blvd, as well as the Tabor Park South Beach.
