Enrolled Sites and Camps

The City of New Bedford Parks Recreation & Beaches Department is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all eligible children free of charge. Children who are part of households that receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly food stamps) benefits or benefits under the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) are automatically eligible to receive free meals.

Acceptance and participation requirements for the Program and all activities are the same for all regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

The City of New Bedford is partnering with public enrolled programs at public schools, local churches, and community centers to provide meals through the Summer Food Service Program. Ask your Summer provider if they are participating, or contact New Bedford Parks Recreation & Beaches Department at 508-961-3015 to find out more information.
