PLANTING REGULATIONS

ANNUAL FLOWERS (geraniums, ageratums, marigolds, petunias, impatiens, etc.) **ARE ALLOWED AND WILL NOT BE REMOVED** if planted in the flowerbed.

ARTIFICIAL (plastic, wood, and/or silk) flowers, greens, ornaments are allowed. **ONLY FROM NOVEMBER 1st to MARCH 1st.**

All flowers, Christmas decorations, etc. will be removed on or about March 1st, if not picked up by the lot owner and/or families.

All baskets, pots and flowers placed at graves for Memorial Day will be removed on or about June 10th, if not picked up by the lot owner and/or families.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ALLOWED:

FENCES and/or CURBING of any kind
PLASTIC, WOOD or RUBBER EDGING
WOOD CHIPS and/or STONE CHIPS
SHRUBS, AZALEAS and/or ROSEBUSHES
PERENNIAL FLOWERS
VIGIL LIGHTS or SOLAR LIGHTS

Flower beds are not to exceed twelve inches (12") from the base of the monument or marker.

If violated, the Superintendent of Cemeteries has the full vote of the Cemetery Board to remove any and all shrubs, flowers or ornaments and to seed the area.

ANY AND ALL ITEMS PLANTED OR PLACED AT THE GRAVESITE IS AT THE LOT OWNERS RISK.
