FIRE STATION #8 ROOF REPLACEMENT AND REPOINTING PROJECT

from qualified bidders, in accordance with MGL Chapter 149, under the procedures of Chapter 30, Section 39M, as amended, and as provided under applicable sections of Chapter 193 of the Acts of 2004.

Sealed Bids for the General Contract will be received by the New Bedford Purchasing Department, 133 William Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, 02740 until 1:00 p.m. Thursday, November 6, 2014 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Included with General Bid shall be an Update Statement, DCAM Certification and 5% bid deposit. The work of this project is predominately Roofing. A DCAM Certified Roofer shall be the Prime General Contract for this project.

Sealed Bids for the following sub-trade: Masonry - shall be received by the New Bedford Purchasing Department, 133 William Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts, 02740 until 1:00 p.m., on Thursday, October 30 2014 which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Included with Sub-bids shall be an Update Statement, DCAM Certification and 5% bid deposit.

Bidders may obtain one (1) complete set of Drawings and Specifications upon deposit of \$75.00 in the form of cash or by certified or cashier's check made payable to City of New Bedford. Documents will be available after 10:00 am. Thursday, October 16, 2014 Monday through Friday 9:00 – 4:00 pm. at Mount Vernon Group, Architects, Inc. 47 North Second Street, New Bedford, MA 02740. The full amount of deposit will be refunded to all Bidders returning Drawings and Specifications in good condition within ten (10) days after date of General Bid opening. If Drawings and Specifications are requested to be mailed, submit a check (non-refundable) payable to City of New Bedford, in the amount of \$25.00 for standard UPS delivery.

Wages to be paid shall not be less than the rate of wages determined for this Work by the Commissioner of Labor and Industries of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 28, as amended, a schedule of which appears in the Specifications.

The Work of this Project shall require Minority/Women Owned Business participation pursuant to Chapter 193 of the Acts of 2004, and MGL Chapter 23A, Section 44 and MGL Chapter 7, Section 40N, as amended, and established as a policy by the City of New Bedford.

All bids shall remain in effect for thirty (30) days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of General Bids.
