Winter Storm Forecast Upgraded, City Announces Closings and Delays

New Bedford, Massachusetts – The National Weather Service has upgraded the Winter Storm Watch in effect for Southern Bristol County, including New Bedford, to a Winter Storm Warning due to greater than earlier anticipated snow accumulation. The upgraded Warning will remain in effect until 7 PM tonight. The revised local forecast for Greater New Bedford calls for total snow accumulation in the 6 – 10 inch range and temperatures tonight will be much colder with lows around 10 degrees.

Pilgrim United Church (634 Purchase Street) will open as of 5:30PM for unsheltered residents. The church will be equipped with staff, food and cots.

All New Bedford Public Library Branches including the Main Library Downtown will be closing at 5PM today, Thursday, March 5, 2015.
